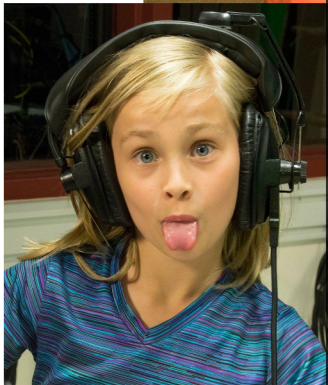

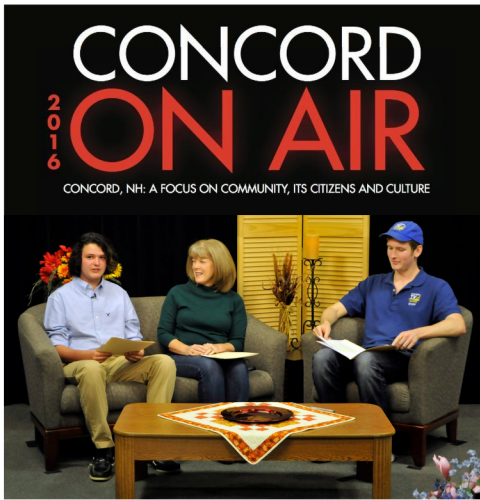
ConcordTV staff captured the activity during construction of the **Sewalls Falls Bridge** and shared this important content on the Government Channel 17 for the public to view.

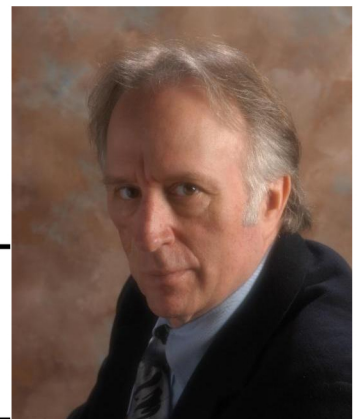

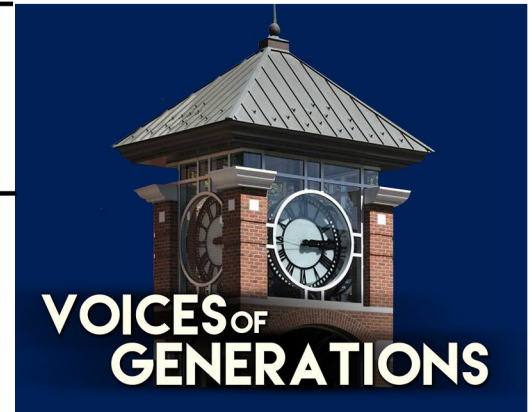
NOVEMBER & DECEMBER 2016

ConcordTV staff and volunteers (photo shows Charlie Russell (l) and Roger Brooks (r) on set) collaborated in capturing the excitement of the day, from getting interviews at the polls and announcing live election results on how Concord residents voted, to featuring candidates who dropped by the studio after the polls closed.



As a 2016 holiday gift to the community, the film **Voices of Generations**, that was created as a contribution to the city's 250th anniversary celebration, debuted on ConcordTV channel 22. It featured 25 senior citizens of Concord telling their stories about their life in the city.



Boys & Girls Club 2016 Auction

The presentation resulted in the creation of a Public Service Announcement of this Chamber of Commerce program for promotional use.

By The Numbers

Equipment and Studio usage and training in FY 2016-2017

More than **35** individuals signed out field equipment at an approximate value of **\$110,000**.

There were **45** Producer Support Program shows created in the ConcordTV studio by individual producers resulting in **115** episodes of **CHS Live** and **40** other independent studio uses...an approximate value of **\$95,000**.

29 adult classes in Camera, Editing and Special Workshops were held bringing in **\$1,394** in revenue.

Community Conversations

12 Community Conversations shows were taped in the studio and at New England College's location on Main Street featuring: Affordable Care Act; City of Concord Trails; Concord High Poetry Out Loud winner; Concord Public Library; Families in Transition: How to Festival; Intown Concord; Junior Service League; L'il Iguana Children's Safety Foundation; NH Film Office; Red River Theatres; Traumatic Brain Injury



Poetry Out Loud

Concord High School student Laila Ruffin, who won the school's annual Poetry Out Loud competition, was featured on **Community Conversations**, a monthly TV show and podcast produced by ConcordTV. This poetry competition is also taped by ConcordTV staff for distribution on the Education channel 6 and online.

NHTI Dancing with the Concord Stars

Since its inception, ConcordTV has taped the **Dancing with the Concord Stars** event, a major annual fundraiser for NHTI's Community College which occurs every January. The entire event is then scheduled on channel 22 for the public (and dance participants) to enjoy.

ConcordTV Video Camps during April and Summer vacations open the worlds of filmmaking and digital media for over **60** campers each year. Funds from **Easter Eggstravaganza** purchase new video equipment for video camps, staff and community-made public access programs.

Easter Eggstravaganza 2

ConcordTV's **Second Annual Easter Eggstravaganza** out-performed its first year, welcoming over **1,200** guests over the three-day festival. **30** donors and business sponsors brought in **\$6,541** to support the event (and Concord On Air) and Easter Eggstravaganza "2" raised a net revenue of **\$12,139.95**. The fun festival displayed over **200** Easter Baskets, **10** Live Entertainment performances, **8** Kids Activity tables (sponsored by civic and nonprofit organizations). Raffles were highlighted by offerings for moms, dads, girls and boys - plus a Silent Auction. Special appearances by live characters - "Belle," NHTI's Mascot and The Easter Bunny - delighted kids of all ages. Once again, the spacious and attractive **Bektash Shrine Center** proved the perfect venue for this event.

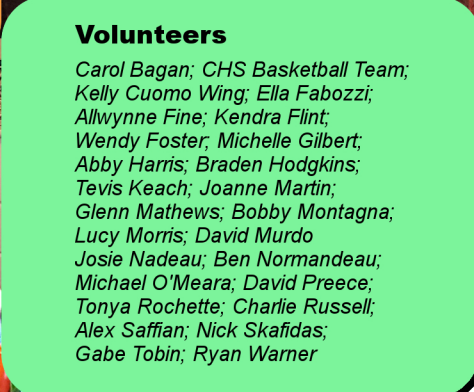
