## YOUTH VIDEO CAMPS

ConcordTV staff taught four weeks of summer **Youth Video Camps** for the city's Parks and Recreation Department with **48** students participating. Thanks to Aidan Allen, a former camp graduate, for helping the staff with another year of successful TV and video education opportunities for our community's youth.

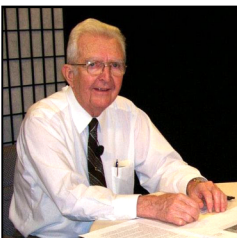
## HOLIDAY GREETINGS

## IN MEMORIAM BOB DENZ

ConcordTV lost another of its dedicated volunteers, **Bob Denz**, who passed away on February 8, 2018. Bob assumed the hosting duties of **SeniorSpeakNH** from long-time host Bob Williams after he retired as host of the show in 2007. According to his obituary, Bob Denz was also "a dedicated volunteer for AARP NH, serving as acting President and its chief spokesperson. He helped initiate and was active in AARP's Fraud Watch Network. Issues affecting seniors, veterans and the more vulnerable citizens of our communities were near and dear to his heart." His expertise in senior issues was invaluable to the program and we will always be thankful for the countless hours that he and Bob Williams (who also passed away a few months prior in December 2017) contributed over the years to this popular program.
